Dress Code

The purpose of the St. Martin's dress code is to support a positive learning environment. We want to create an environment that will be comfortable for students and conducive to learning. One of the social skills that can be developed in school is how to dress appropriately for a specific environment or event. Throughout our lives, we dress according to the situation we are in, and school is no exception.

Required Shirt: St. Martin's logo polo shirt that can be ordered from Land's End. It can be long sleeved, or short sleeved (mesh or interlock). The colors can be cobalt blue, classic navy or white.

Dress Pants: Solid khaki, navy or black: Leggings are not considered pants.

Dress Shorts or Capri Pants: Solid khaki, navy or black: Shorts and capris cannot be worn between November March. Shorts must be a modest length.

Belt: A belt is required in grades 3-8 with pants that contain belt loops

Skirts/Jumpers/Shorts/Dresses: Solid khaki, navy or black: Jumpers must have a sleeved shirt underneath. School logo is required on jumpers. Skirts, jumpers, shorts and dresses must be a modest length.

Optional Sweater /Sweatshirt: The sweater style can be cardigan, V-neck, crewneck or sweater vest. Solid color only. The school logo is required on sweaters.

Shoes: Flat, closed toe and closed heeled, tied or Velcro strap shoes. Athletic shoes are acceptable. Boots are permitted in winter months only. Socks or tights/leggings must be worn with shoes.

Other: Girls may wear single earrings. Boys may not wear earrings. Boys hair should be cut neatly at ear length and above the brows and collar.
